RARPA (Recording and Recognising Progress and Achievement)

- RARPA is a mandatory quality assurance system for all currently state funded non-accredited learning provision, E2E and Foundation learning
- RARPA will become mandatory for all state funded learning inspection under the Common Inspection Framework from 2008
- RARPA is an excellent way of ensuring the quality of learning funded from sources other than state funding
- RARPA offers a simple 5 stage process to ensure quality

The training will be conducted by Phil Eaton, a specialist consultant who has been presenting RARPA training nationally for NIACE. RARPA is becoming increasingly important for all non-accredited learning and for the Common Inspection Framework.
